## **RESOLUTION 2023-10**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "the Board", believes the County Hwy F32, Project No. STP-S-C005(78)--5E-05, hereafter referred to as "the project" is in the best interest of Audubon County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as HMA Pavement Widening/HMA Resurfacing of County Hwy F32, from County Hwy M66 east 7.2 miles to US Hwy 71; and

WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting; and WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Audubon County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by Board to accept the bid from Henningsen Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$5,144,916.70 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of The Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Audubon County, lowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, Mitchel J. Rydl, P.E., the Audubon County Engineer for Audubon County, lowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.

## **RESOLUTION 2023-11**

WHEREAS, by authority of the Iowa Code, 2023, Section 321.345 the Audubon County Board of Supervisors for Audubon County "may designate through highways and erect stop signs or yield signs in accordance with specifications established by the Iowa Department of Transportation, Highway Division, at specified entrances thereto or may designate any intersection as a stop intersection or as a yield intersection and erect signs at one or more entrances to such intersection".
