The meeting of the Board of Supervisors was called to order at 12:04 pm by Chairman Heath Hansen. Present at the meeting were Heath Hansen, Kent Grabill, Don Mosinski, Lisa Frederiksen, Chassity Musfeldt, John Hansen and William Baylor.

Motion-Grabill Second- Mosinski to approve the agenda with the addition to give a Veteran's Affairs update. Vote-all in favor. Custodian Hansen inquired about what to do with the shelving that is still up at the Armory. Hansen said they requested it to be removed by February 18<sup>th</sup>. Due to the shape it is in and lack of storage at the Courthouse, he recommends disposing of it at the landfill. Motion- Mosinski Second- Grabill to approve the disposal of the shelving.
