

March 31st, 2026

The meeting of the Board of Supervisors was called to order at 9:09 am by Chairman Kent Grabill. Present at the meeting were Kent Grabill, Don Mosinski, Heath Hansen, Lisa Frederiksen, Chassity Musfeldt, Sarah Irlbeck, Clark Borkowski, and Robert Malloy.

Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the agenda. Vote-all in favor. Sarah Irlbeck joined the meeting to discuss Child Abuse Awareness Month in April. Irlbeck would like to display the pinwheels in honor of Child Abuse Awareness in April. Irlbeck would like everyone to wear blue next Tuesday, April 7th to display support and participate in a group photo. April 19th through the 25th is National Crime Victim Awareness Week. Irlbeck would like to hang informative flyers regarding this next week. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the Pinwheel Project and the flyers for Crime Victim Awareness week. Vote-all in favor.

Public Comment was opened at 9:15 am. The Courthouse Custodian/Maintenance open position was discussed. Supervisors reviewed the job description. Chairman Grabill drafted an advertisement for the newspaper. The starting wage will range from \$45,000-\$50,000/year, plus benefits, depending on experience. Applications will be due to the Auditor's Office by April 16th at 4:00 pm. Supervisors would like to get this advertisement sent to the newspaper this week. Motion- Hansen Second- to approve the job advertisement for publication as stated. Vote-all in favor.

Lisa Frederiksen gave Auditor Office updates. Frederiksen discussed the last possible dates to have the final FY27 budget hearing. The last possible day to certify the budget is April 30th, 2026. Once the budget is certified, budgets can still be cut, just not added to. Supervisors still have a few department budgets they would like to review. Auditor's Office will be closed tomorrow for State Election training in Fort Dodge.

The ACED agreement was discussed. Attorney Swensen was unavailable for updates at today's meeting. Mosinski had spoken with Sara Slater last week, and they were currently reviewing. After the final agreement is reviewed, Mosinski would like to discuss a budget amendment for a FY26 ACED allocation.

The FY27 insurance renewals were reviewed last week but tabled after having a few questions on the totals. Auditor Frederiksen and Chairman Grabill went through the spreadsheet with the updated totals, and everything looks good. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the FY27 Assured Partners insurance renewal documents. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve claims as submitted by various departments to be paid in the amount of \$44,303.82 and published in a separate publication at the end month. Vote-all in favor. Supervisor Hansen left the meeting at 10:09 am. Motion- Mosinski Second- Grabill to approve the meeting minutes of March 24th, 2026, the special meeting minutes of March 24th, 2026, and March 30th, 2026. Vote-all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 10:29 am.
