The meeting of the Board of Supervisors was called to order at 9:02 am by Chairman Kent Grabill. Present at the meeting were Kent Grabill, Heath Hansen, Don Mosinski, Chassity Musfeldt, Miranda Wachter, Ben Linde, Jotham Arber, Lisa Frederiksen, and Mitch Rydl.

Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve the agenda. Vote-all in favor. Chairman Grabill gave an update on the National Flood Insurance Program from the meeting last week. They have requested additional information from the DNR. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the following DNR MMP Annual Updates/Changes for the following: Multi-Pig #61060; Cottonwood #63260; Brad Weber #62423 and Klocke (D Robinson) #64023. Vote-all in favor.

Miranda Wachter, District Leader of District 4 met with the Supervisors to discuss updates on the Behavioral Health Redesign and give an overview of what services are provided to the communities. They have a Statewide service that is available to everyone and can give guidance to find healthcare/behavioral needs. Iowa Primary Care funds several different services throughout the State.

Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the meeting minutes of July 21st, 2026. Vote-all in favor. IT Director Ben Linde discussed the quotes for a new website and said he has set up a Zoom meeting with Neapolitan Labs next Tuesday at 9:30 am. Supervisors reviewed the fixed assets added & deleted from FY26.

Jotham Arber with Public Health gave a recap of the services provided in the month of June 2026. They will be offering back to school physicals and free clinics again soon. Arber elaborated on the Measles outbreaks and the availability of vaccinations. Environmental Health has been busy doing soil analysis samples, perc tests and other services.

Lisa Frederiksen discussed recent updates from the Auditor's Office. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the OCIO Driver License User Letter. Vote-all in favor. The State Auditor's will be on site in the Courthouse today through Thursday. The IMWCA auditor will be here today as well. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve setting the FY27 Budget Amendment #1 for August 18th, 2026, at 10:00 am. Vote-all in favor.

Engineer Rydl gave Secondary Roads construction & maintenance updates. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve pay estimate #5 for the Mockingbird Paving Project. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the pay estimate #4 for LE-8 bridge replacement project. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve pay estimate #1 for LFM-East Side Drive. Vote-all in favor. Rydl discussed spraying weeds in the right of way areas of intersections, the costs, and the DNR regulations. Upcoming project plans were discussed. Meeting adjourned at 11:24 am.
