

# **Notice of Vacancy**

## **Audubon County Veterans Affairs Commission**

**Audubon County Veterans Affairs** is accepting applications to serve on the Veterans Affairs Commission for at least a 3-year term. Commissioners are compensated \$50.00 per month plus reimbursed mileage at the county rate of \$.60 per mile (2026). Per Iowa Code 69.16A the Commission is seeking a veteran to maintain a 3-member commission.

**Qualifications:** applicant must be an honorably discharged veteran, an Audubon County resident, and able to attend monthly meetings. It is requested that the new Commissioner attend a 1-day state training over zoom or in person with Region 12 counsel of governments in Carroll, Iowa. This is H.F. 706 Iowa Code Chapter 21-22. This new training must be completed within 90 days of taking oath. Applicants DD214 must be provided for verification.

**Duties:** The Commission currently meets one day a month at 8 am in the VA office in the courthouse, however this may change to accommodate current Commissioners schedules. The

Commission is responsible for the execution of Chapter 35B, Code of Iowa. Items to be discussed and decided on monthly meetings include, but not limited to:

Office operations and activity

Veteran county assistance requests and appeals reviewed and voted on

Review of expenditures and budget

Formulate and implement new ideas, update policy

Receive input from county Veterans, Veteran Service Organizations, and the public, on any matter relevant to local veterans or the commission
