Request for Camera Equipment-

Police Chief Starmer presented the Council with 2 competing bids for providing security cameras in the Police Station and in the Memorial Building. One was Walsh Door and Hardware for \$14,727.44 and from Feld Security for \$6,330. Whetzal moved, Murray seconded to approve Feld Security. ALL AYED.

Resolution for Credit cards-

Murray moved, Whetzal seconded, to adopt the resolution creating a Credit card policy for the City to handle some expenses. ROLL CALL: AYES; Murray, Whetzal, Hocker, Jacobsen, Hemmingsen, NAYS; none RESOLUTION PASSED 5-0

Overtime management-

Council discussed the reasoning behind overtime in the Police department and in Public Works. The question was raised if a fourth officer would be a better use of resources. A schedule of rotation and additional person with Chemical Certifications was discussed for the Public Works. NO ACTION TAKEN

Comments and Propositions-

Mayor-

addressed Thygesen about a complaint from a resident about sewer back up and not being able to use toilet. Thygesen explained that new mandates from DNR for location of bypass pumps are not working like it previously would. He will contact the resident.

Whetzal-

showed a picture of one of the PW employees up in a bucket and questioned if they were harnessed per OSHA requirements. Thygesen assured the Council that the employee had a harness on.
